

## Legislative

### **Recap of 2010 Session and SB 550**

Over 2000 bills filed and more than 300 passed.

HB 1565 – SERC cost >\$1 M aggregate would need legislative approval was vetoed.

### SB550

- Legislative findings against NNC (FWEAUC)
- WWTF/Reclaimed Water providers now part of Water Supply Planning (Reclaimed Work Group)
  - Coordination with WMDs required
- CUP Compliance Report from 5 to 10 years
- Chapter 373 re-write to Part VII – Water Supply Planning (FSAWWA initiative)
- Revocation of delegation of authority from WMD GBs to ED for CUPs
- Prohibition of GB intervention in a permit until it is brought in front of the Board
- Mandatory Septic Tank Inspection Program
- Ban of land application of septage – NOT BIOSOLIDS (FWEAUC Win)

## Regulatory

### **Federal:**

#### Numeric Nutrient Criteria Update

### **Statewide:**

Waterbody Classification Rule – Passed ERC (SEFLUC unsuccessful in efforts to change rule – requested DEP go back to original proposal or expand Class III limited, clarification/streamlining of SSAC process, and clarification of impact on CUP process)

Stormwater Rule – DEP held workshops: New Development and Urban systems only. Focus on Water Quality. Will require WMD rulemaking to adopt. Next version of handbook is due out in October 2010.

Backflow/Cross Connection Rule – no update

Operator Certification (reminder) – May 2011 deadline approaching

Biosolids Rule – ERC approved proposed amendments – they tried to file an amendment to ban “giving away” class AA biosolids, however, FWEAUC intervened and this amendment failed. The ERC did pass amendments that address the storage of class AA and compliance schedule. Final version of the rule is yet to be published.

**Regional:**

SFWMD – Will give presentation to SEFLUC on July 12, 2010

- Historic Impact to Wetlands – how do you address past harm and predict future? How do you determine degree of multiple points of impact?
- 10-yr. CUP Report – What should be contained in this report – perhaps tiered level response type of process
- Multiple Source Permitting – balance of allocations vs. balance of operational needs/constraints
